Living arrangements

TasTAFE has campuses in both of Tasmania's main cities, Hobart and Launceston, so you are able to choose which city you would like to live in. The three main living options for TasTAFE students, include: on-campus accommodation, private rental, or with a homestay family.

Diploma + Degree pathways

TasTAFE partners with the University of Tasmania to deliver Diploma + Degree packages. TasTAFE has a range of courses available to students that provide graduates with two qualifications: an Advanced Diploma/Diploma and a Bachelor Degree.


Complete one of the Diploma + Degree packages and you may receive direct entry into the second year of a Bachelor Degree.

Our Diploma + Degree Packages offer several benefits:

- Direct entry into TasTAFE courses from IELTS 5.5. You can start your course with lower IELTS than is required by Universities, while gaining work placement training at the same time
- Dual qualification in your chosen field
- Provides practical work experience and career focused skills via TasTAFE to complement the higher level theory at University
- Significantly reduces the total cost of obtaining a Bachelor's Degree.

English Language Requirements

All of our courses are delivered in English, therefore TasTAFE has stringent English language requirements.

If you do not meet the minimum English language requirement for direct entry into your chosen course (see table below), we organise packaged English offers in Hobart or Launceston.

If you have not completed one of the English language tests, in the table below, TasTAFE can provide you with an Oxford Online test to complete (not applicable for nursing).

Please note: Whilst the Oxford Online test is accepted by TasTAFE as a demonstration of English Language level, the Australian Department of Home Affairs may require an IELTS test as part of your student visa application process. Please talk to your nearest Australian Department of Home Affairs office for more information.

Tuition Fees*

Tuition fees at TasTAFE provide students with an affordable study option. On average, tuition at TasTAFE will cost \$AU12,000 per year.

Cost of Living

The annual cost of living is lower in Tasmania than other Australian states. Students should budget AUD\$23,600 to AUD\$29,000 per year to cover accommodation, transport, food, electricity and entertainment.
