

Tasmanian Government Schools

2021 Scholarship Program

Scholarship Eligibility

Scholarships are available for any student who applies to study in a Tasmanian Government School for a minimum study period of 2 years.

Value of Each Scholarship

- Scholarships are to be valued at 25% of the value of the first year tuition fee
- The scholarship recipients will also receive the opportunity to act as Tasmanian Government Education Ambassadors during their time in Tasmania. Upon graduation they will receive an additional gift and special certificate for this contribution

Scholarship Allocation

The Tasmanian Government will award scholarships to 26 students. Four Scholarships will be allocated to students from each of the following markets:

- China
- Vietnam
- South Korea
- Japan
- Hong Kong

An additional 6 scholarships will be awarded, that are not allocated to any specific country.

Scholarship Criteria

On the application form you will be required to provide a short response of 150 words maximum, to each of the following questions

- Why have you chosen to study in Tasmania?
- Briefly outline three (3) achievements you are proud of (e.g., academic, sport, arts, leadership, community):
- In your home country, what is your favourite subject and why?
- How will you make a contribution to the Tasmanian Government School's co-curricular activities programme and to the general life of the School:

Key Dates

- Students must apply by October 31, 2020.
- Applicants will be informed of the outcome by November 6, 2020.
- Students will need to commence their studies one of the following intakes:
 - February 2021
 - April 2021
 - July 2021
 - October 2021
 - February 2022

How to Enter

- Submit an application to study in Tasmania using the StudyLink Portal.
- You will receive the application form via an email from the Studylink Portal
- Attach the completed application form to a return email in the StudyLink Portal.

The Scholarship applications will be judged on the following two criteria:

75% - The student's personal response

25% - The quality of the student's school report from their home country (Already submitted as part of the student application)
