Intake dates	February, April, July and October
Location	Hobart
Entry requirements	Students must be at least 18 years and must have an English level of IELTS 3.0 (or equivalent)
Conditions	Study full time, commencing a minimum of 10 weeks General English Course. Scholarship will be applied as a deduction from ELICOS tuition fees. Students need to pay any remaining ELICOS tuition fees not covered by the scholarship. Scholarship funding is capped at AU \$1,400 per student.

English Language Student


"I chose to study in Tasmania because of the reputation in education excellence.
